- WHEREAS:** Together we can make a difference by creating positive change in our community and world – one good deed at a time.


NOW,
THEREFORE: I, John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., Governor of the State of Oregon, hereby proclaim **April 26, 2012** to be


PAY IT FORWARD DAY
