Volunteer Code of Ethics

- Fulfill their duties, obligations and responsibilities with integrity and represent Pay It Forward Day in a conscientious, respectful and efficient manner.
- Strive to provide the highest quality of service.
- Treat with respect the views and actions of their colleagues and use appropriate organizational channels to express disagreement if required.
- Clearly distinguish between their own opinions as individuals, and their statements as representatives
 of the organization. They will exercise responsible caution in dealing with public and media
